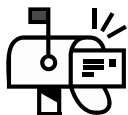

Jerri has worked with teens, counselors, teachers, and administrators for many years in the state of Kansas. Jerri is currently employed at USD #397 Centre School District as the K-4 Principal and Superintendent. Jerri has presented the "Power of One" workshops at ESU for the past six years which have been designed to provide K-6 counselors, teachers, and administrators with hands on ideas to incorporate character education into the schools. Anyone who knows Jerri knows that character education is definitely one of her passions, and she truly has a gift of motivating others to teach character education in the schools. Jerri is the recipient of the 2007 Alfred P. Wilson Scholarship in Educational Leadership Award from KSU and is also the recipient of the 2003 Kansas Counselor of the Year Award. Jerri has also been the keynote speaker for the Character Education Teacher Institute in Topeka, and she has worked with school districts in Texas providing them with inservice training in character education. Students and sponsors will be inspired and motivated by Jerri Kemble's message.
