Jim was the 2008/09 ASCA President. He is the Lead Counselor for Minneapolis Public Schools, an adjunct professor at the University of Minnesota, a part-time counselor at Henry High School, and a counselor/tutor at homeless shelters. He has been an elementary, junior high, and high school counselor. His website contains 80 articles and 230 school counseling lessons that he authored. He is on the National College Board Advisory Council, was a co-writer for the National Board of Professional Teaching Standards (NBPTS) School Counselor Standards, and was a member of three school counseling teams that implemented the ASCA National Model and produced positive systemic change.
